## **Year 4 BF Adventure 7-8 May 2024**

I am delighted to inform you that we have arranged a 2 day, 1 night residential for Year 4 pupils at the BF Adventure Activity Centre, between Penryn and Helston, next May. BF is an excellent centre for outdoor pursuits. For more information about the centre please visit their website - [www.bfadventure.org](http://www.bfadventure.org).

The children will travel from school by coach and will leave school at 11.30 am to arrive at camp by midday, in time for afternoon activities on the Tuesday. They will stay overnight in cabins and take part in a full day of activities on the Wednesday and arrive back at school on Wednesday afternoon. Children will need a packed lunch on the first day, a packed lunch can be booked from the school kitchen.

All the activities are organised and supervised by fully trained activity leaders. The children will take part in several different activities which are likely to include climbing and abseiling, archery and problem solving. The activity programme will be finalised nearer the time of the trip. Meals will be provided by BF staff.

The cost of the visit, including transport to and from the centre, food, accommodation and all activities is £145 per child. We ask for a deposit of £40.00 by Monday 4 September 2023. You can pay the balance in instalments or in full by **Thursday 27 March 2024**. **All payments will need to be paid using your online Parent Pay Account.**

We are hoping that every child in the class will be able to take part in the camp. Please contact me if funding the visit is a problem or your child has any special requirements. The school will try to support you. Any pupils not taking part will join other junior classes for the two days.
