A firm favourite in the KSF diary, and something that really kicks off the Christmas Spirit! Starting on Monday 21 November Kea School Friends will be hosting our Wrapping Room during lunch breaks. For those of you that are new to Kea, this event allows your child(ren) to come along during an allocated lunchtime to buy gifts for parents, siblings and other family members. KSF spend time purchasing and wrapping gifts for the children to come along and select, and write name tags. They will then bring gifts home to put under the Christmas tree for their loved ones. Gifts range from £1.50 - £4.

Nearer the time we will let everyone know which day has been allocated to each year group so everyone will know which day to bring in their money. KSF volunteers, and other helpers, will be available each day to support children with selecting and budgeting their gifts and will support children with writing their name tags, as required.

Some of the gifts this year include: themed drink tumblers, bath bombs, chocolates, musical intruments, christmas socks and candles, plus lots MORE!

This is a really magical event for the childen and their families. It also really supports the children with their maths, writing skills and independence.



Since September we have raised an AMAZING £360 through uniform sales and tuckshops. However, we have allocated £2150 to pay for coaches to Lanhydrock, Trelissick, and Kea Church so the children can attend school workshops, plus visits to the Hall for Cornwall and Choirfest in Truro Cathedral. We have also bought subscriptions to TimesTable Rockstars and Sing-Up. Finally, we've purchased new cooking equipment so the classes can restart cooking in school.

As you can see, we have spent more than we have made so far this term, so we are hopeful for lots of support at the Wrapping Room, Christmas Fayre and Christmas Cards.
