*LSCWC= Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check. For each word children should look closely at the word, say the word, cover the word up, write the word and then check to see if they spelt it correctly.

For Level 1 homework, the week runs from a Friday to Friday

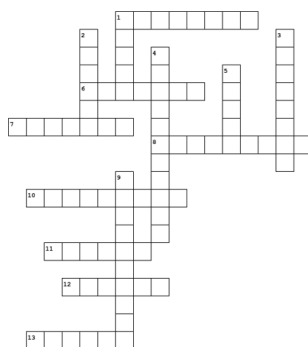

1. Order of the planets: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune
2. The Earth orbits the Sun and it takes 365.25 days.
3. Earth takes 24 hours to spin on it's axis; when it faces the sun, it's daytime. When it's in shadow, it is nighttime.
4. The Moon orbits the Earth and appears to change shape when the sun lights up different parts of it.
5. There's a range of evidence for Earth being spherical

Level 3 Homework (we would love you to have a go at these ongoing projects, artwork or research tasks and bring them in when ready)

Piece 1 - The Royal Mint is holding a short story competition based on the topic coins and the sea. They are exploring the role coins have played in Britain's history of seafaring.
