
The text types we are learning about this half term are:

MATHS

We will be learning about place value and addition, subtraction, multiplication and division methods.

- I can recognise, write, represent and order numbers up to 10, 000, 000.
- I can round numbers to 10, 100 and 1000.
- I understand negative numbers.
- I can multiply a 4-digit number by a 2-digit number.
- I can complete short and long division.
- I can find prime numbers to 100.
- I can solve multi-step problems.
- I can recognise square and cube numbers.







SCIENCE

We will be learning about the main functions of the human circulatory system?

- I can describe the heart's location and function.
- I can summarise and compare the functions of different blood cells.
- I know what a heart rate is and what factors affect it. (investigation)
- I know how nutrients and water are transported around the body.
- I can explore scientific research about the relationship between diet, exercise, drugs and health.
- I can explain how to keep my heart and body healthy.

- I can identify how rivers erode, transport and deposit materials.






- I. London, Birmingham and Liverpool are 3 of the most populated cities in the U.K.

- Express my nationality in French and understand basic gender agreement rules.






We will be learning about Hockey and Tag Rugby. Tag Rugby.

- decide the best way to attack in a game situation.






MUSIC


We will be learning about syncopated melody using 'Hey Mr Miller!'
