Mrs. Green's RWI group learn either list 1 and 2, or list 3 and 4.

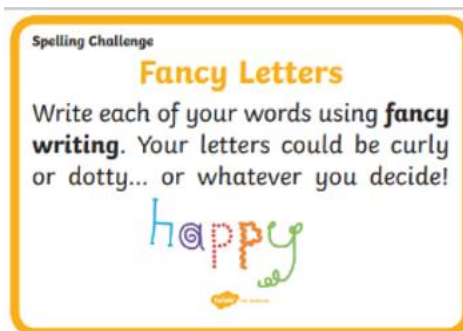
Miss Reeve's RWI group learn list 2 and 5 of the red words from your read write ink book.

Level 3 Homework (we would love you to have a go at these ongoing projects, artwork or research tasks and bring them in when ready)

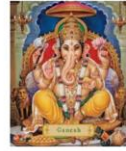
This term we will be learning about Hinduism. In this religion, God has many forms and aspects, here are a few of those we will be learning about.

Rama

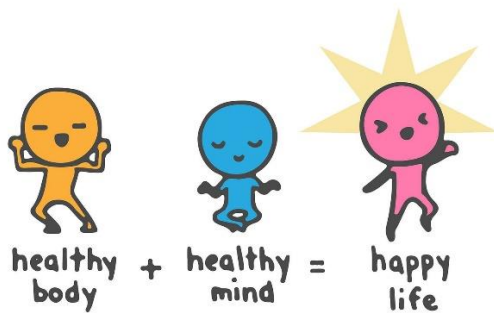
