Governor Observations and Comments I spoke with Mrs Hunkin today in relation to Pupil Premium. Due to the amount of time in lockdown in the Spring term no meeting has taken place until now. However Pupil Premium has been on the Full Governing Body agenda and Mrs Hunkin has provided updates throughout. Mrs Hunkin informed me that all class teachers had updated lists of the PP children in their classes following the children returning to school. There has not been any movement in numbers with the only exception being new pupils to the school who have joined in the last few weeks. All teachers are monitoring progress and data will be reviewed this week, prior to the full governing body meeting. Once the data has been analysed a subsequent meeting will be held.
