Dear Parents and Carers

As part of our Autumn 1 topic 'Cornish Myths and Legends', Y1 and Y2 will be visiting St Michael's Mount on Friday 15 September 2023. On this trip the children will be learning about different legends relating to St Michaels's Mount including Cormoran the Giant. There is no cost to parents for this visit.

The coach will be leaving school at 9.15 am and the children will return by 3.00 pm. Kea School Friends have very kindly offered to fund the transport costs for this visit. The children will need to bring a water bottle (no glass bottles) and packed lunch (or a packed lunch can be ordered from the school kitchen). We will be outside for most of the day, so it is essential that the children bring a coat, hat and gloves to stay warm and dry. Please can the children all wear normal school uniform. Due to the tide times on this day, the causeway will be open for us to walk there and back, so please make sure your child is wearing suitable comfortable shoes.

A small number of adult volunteers will be needed for this trip. We have a limit on adults that can gain entry into St Michael's Mount to assist with the visit. If you are available to help, then please indicate on the consent form. Please note that priority will be given to volunteers that have a valid DBS certificate.
