Dear Parents and Carers

As part of our Spring 2 topic 'What a Wonderful World!', YF, Y1 and Y2 will be visiting Newquay Zoo on Tuesday 21 February 2023. On this trip the children will be learning about different animals, habitats and plants that are in our wonderful world. There is no cost for this trip due to Newquay Zoo running a 'Schools go free in 23' offer. This is to celebrate the 100th year anniversary of their sister zoo at Paignton. Kea School Friends have very kindly agreed to pay the coach hire for this visit.

The coach will be leaving school at 9.30 am and the children will return by 3.10 pm. The children will need to bring a water bottle (no glass bottles) and a packed lunch (or a packed lunch can be ordered from the school kitchen). We will be outside for most of the day, so it is essential that the children bring a coat, hat and gloves to stay warm and dry. Children will need to wear their normal school uniform on this day (PE will not take place on this day).

A small number of adult volunteers will be needed for this trip. We have a limit on adults that can enter Newquay Zoo to assist with the visit. If you are available to help, then please indicate on the consent form. Please note that priority will be given to volunteers that hold a valid DBS certificate. Volunteers would have to be able to make their own way to and from the zoo.
