Literacy

Reading

Reading

Read your reading book daily, either borrowed from the box in reception at school or online. Also practise some of your red words.

Handwriting

This week, choose a couple of red words from the red word list at the front of your reading record to practise writing. You can also find the red words on the general resources page on the website.

<p>Literacy Tasks</p>	<p><u>Monday</u></p> <p>Watch today's video Literacy lesson. The children will learn all about St David's Day and talk about flags and dragons. Later, they will be able to design their own dragon (drawing a picture or constructing it out of something) or colour in a picture of a dragon. Writing options could include naming their dragon, labelling it or writing a sentence describing it.</p> <p><u>Tuesday</u></p> <p>Watch today's video Literacy lesson. Today, the children will explore a simple box. What could your box be used for? The children will be able to use their imaginations, using the two stories as inspiration, to make something out of their box.</p> <p><u>Wednesday</u></p> <p>Watch today's video Literacy lesson. Today, if you are home learning, we would like you to go onto Tapestry and type what you did with your box yesterday. We would like the children to type this and send it to us. We will then reply back!</p> <p><u>Thursday</u></p> <p>Watch today's video Literacy lesson. The children will learn about Cornish mining and will listen to the story of 'The Man Engine Remembers'. After, they can design their own Man Engine. They could write a little about it if they wish.</p> <p><u>Friday</u></p> <p>Today is St Piran's Day. Literacy will have a St Piran's Day theme today and there are more Cornish themed activities in the afternoon learning. Watch today's video literacy lesson. We will listen to the story 'The Man Engine' and will design our own Man Engines.</p>
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<p>Maths</p>	
<p>This week's maths will introduce 3 areas of learning for the children which we will then follow up once the children are all back in school. The first 3 days will look at height and length and then the last 2 days will look at different aspects of time.</p>	
	<p><u>Monday</u></p>

Watch the video on the White Rose website “Comparing Height – Taller and Shorter”, then have a go at the activity (on the same website, next to the video, or download from our home learning webpage). Try to incorporate the vocabulary of taller than, shorter than throughout the day as much as possible.

Tuesday

Watch the video on the White Rose website “Comparing Length – Longer and Shorter”, then have a go at the activity on the same website (on the same website, next to the video, or download from our home learning webpage). ***If you don't have any playdough, you could use pieces of string, cotton or wool to make your snakes.*** Try to incorporate the vocabulary of longer than, shorter than throughout the day as much as possible.

Wednesday

Watch Mrs Marley's video about measuring height and length.

Draw around your feet and hands and see which items in your house or garden you can find to measure. Do you need to measure the height or the length of it?

Thursday

Watch the video on the White Rose website “Days of the Week”, you could also watch the YouTube videos of “Jasper's Beanstalk” and “The Very Hungry Caterpillar” (Link on home learning page) to reinforce the order of the days of the week. There's also a great song taken from the film “The Addams Family” to help your children remember the days.

Draw a picture of something you like to do or something you like to eat for each day of the week and write the day next to each picture.

Friday

Watch Mrs Marley's video about measuring time.

Choose one or two of Mrs Marley's challenge activities and see how many you can complete in one minute! See if you can improve your score if you do the activity again. Can you make up a challenge of your own?
