	Thursday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In Mrs McPherson's lesson today we will begin writing our riddle on our riddle template so that our answer is hidden. We will be thinking carefully about the order of the clues. We will use adjectives to describe our plant.
	Friday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Today we will be completing our riddle, including a question at the end and a hidden answer. We will check capital letters, full stops and question marks are correctly used. We will check spelling and presentation is our best. We will perform our riddles to a member of the household or class.
